PRE-REGISTRATION

To reserve your child's spot on a 2010 BPJF team, you must do the following:

3. Enclose a check for Duty & Equipment Deposit in the amount of \$150. (Note: This is a change from last year.)
4. Send your Registration Form and payments to the address listed above
5. Pre-registration must be received by April 16, 2010

REGISTRATION DAY

A Final Registration Day will be held on Sunday, May 2, 2010 at the Bethel Park Community Center from 1-4pm. Please be prepared to pay the \$100 Registration Fee and the \$150 Duty & Equipment Deposit.

OTHER INFORMATION

The total registration payment of \$100.00 is required to reserve your child's roster spot. *This fee is refundable up until the end of the first week of practice.* **If the full \$100.00 is not paid by May 2, 2010, your child may lose a reserved roster spot. SPACE IS LIMITED.** Roster spots will be on a first come-first serve basis. **Don't be left out. Avoid being placed on a waiting list. Sign up and pay today!**

As you are well aware, parental participation and well-maintained equipment are essential to our organization. To ensure equal participation and that equipment is returned in good condition by all our families, BPJF enforces the policy of collecting a "DUTY & EQUIPMENT DEPOSIT" at the time of registration. **Each family is required to provide BPJF with a check in the amount of \$150.00 (this is per family, not per player) at the time of registration. This check will not be deposited unless you fail to return all equipment in good condition at Equipment Return or you fail to meet your concession obligations. (Please note that this is a change from last season.)**

If you are a returning BPJF player, please bring your helmet to registration. For your child's safety, it is recommended that Century Sports inspects the fit and pads of your child's helmet.

In addition, Century Sports recommends that you get previously used helmets reconditioned every 3 years. This service costs \$30 and your helmet will be returned by August.

Century Sports will have the following for purchase:

- Schutt Advantage Helmets with mask for \$109.95
- Schutt DNA Helmets with mask for \$159.95
- Hard Chin Strap (Not mandatory, but highly recommended) for \$10

Money is due to Century Sports at the time of transaction.

Please note that Century Sports offers the convenience of their services at our registration, but you are not obligated to purchase your helmet from them. You can purchase a helmet from any vendor.
